To achieve this, the winery avoids synthetic chemicals, using only approved organic substances, and implements practices that enhance soil health, such as compost application. King Estate promotes biodiversity and ecological balance by encouraging beneficial insects and maintaining natural habitats. GMOs are prohibited, and sustainable practices like water conservation and energy efficiency are prioritized. The winery has developed an Organic System Plan (OSP), detailing farming practices and inputs, with meticulous records maintained for traceability. Annual inspections by Oregon Tilth ensure compliance, and any changes are documented and approved. Through these practices, King Estate Winery demonstrates its unwavering commitment to sustainable farming. Our domaine wines, made from our 100% organic and biodynamic® estate vineyard, reflect this dedication to organic principles.

King Estate's Biodynamic Certification

In 2016, King Estate Winery went a step further by achieving Biodynamic certification from Demeter USA. This rigorous certification involves holistic farming practices that go beyond organic standards, emphasizing the integration of crops and livestock, biodiversity, and soil health.
