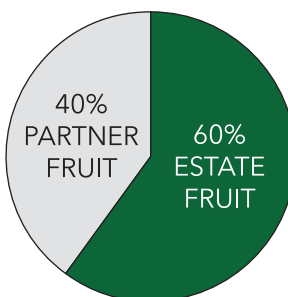

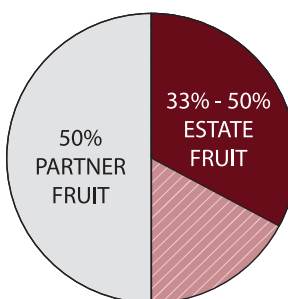
WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT GRIS

In recent years, as much as one-third to one-half of the grapes used to make King Estate Pinot Noir are estate-grown with certified Biodynamic fruit.
